

Base Ball Match.—Guelph vs. Hamilton.—On Friday afternoon last an exciting game of base ball was played between the Maple Leaf Club of Hamilton and the Maple Leaf Club of Guelph, on the grounds of the former. The evenness of the game and the small scores made on both sides, rendered the match one of the most interesting that has been played in that city for a long time. The match throughout was hotly contested—each club earnestly striving to come off victorious.
