I will have to delve deeper to ascertain which rules these were played under (Canada vs. New York or otherwise). I am fairly certain very few are in the former category. The two played in Woodstock as reported in the Clipper of Aug 4, 1860 were played by Canadian rules, with 11 to a side; they are the only ones I recall, but I don't have boxes for all.

These are only games involving Ontario teams (currently), so there are perhaps more to be had from elsewhere. There are two ballclubs formed in 1860 (St. John NB and Montreal), and another in 1863 in Victoria BC, so there must be more games to be found there. ML 27Jul2020
